Course Description: Required training for Law Enforcement Officers to be eligible to receive a Special Law Enforcement Commission (SLEC) for the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Justice Services. All SLEC applicants must pass this course examination with a score of 70% or higher to meet SLEC eligibility requirements.

Who Should Attend: Law Enforcement Officers whose department has an current SLEC agreement in place with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Application Deadline: September 29, 2015

Instructors: The course is presented by the United States Attorney's Office, District of South Dakota.
