Functions of the Office of Tribal Relations</li> <li>Requires the USDA Office of Tribal Relations to oversee self-determination contract and self-governance compacts entered into between the Secretary and tribal organizations or Indian tribes.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Sec. 12212. Tribal Advisory Committee; Self-Determination Pilots</li> <li>Requires that USDA mission areas that have programs with self-determination contracts designate an office or senior official within that mission area that shall be responsible for self-determination contracts and requires the Secretary to designate a senior official on self-determination within the Office of the Secretary to coordinate with the applicable mission area senior officials or offices on Tribal self-determination contracts.</li> <li>Directs the Tribal Advisory Committee (TAC) to make periodic recommendations to the Secretary on self-determination pilot projects of USDA programs and activities.</li> <li>Requires the Secretary to review and respond to the pilot recommendations made by the TAC, with the response submitted to the TAC, the Office of Tribal Relations, and the relevant committees of Congress.</li> </ul>
